## **ORIGINAL bound volumes of the *Santa Fe New Mexican* newspaper, 1916-1937.**

**These are NOT reproductions.**

We have more than 100 bound volumes of the *Santa Fe New Mexican* newspaper, from 1916 through the 1930s, that are for sale. There are also a few from the 1950s. The following is a general description:

These newspapers were hand-bound by the New Mexico State Library/New Mexico State Museum shortly after publication, and were kept in the library's and museum's stacks until microfilm replaced them in the 1950s. The original bound volumes were then sold to the public at that time. They passed through several owners before the New Mexico Transportation History Project (NMTHP) acquired them for research purposes over a decade ago. That research is now complete and we are ready to pass them along to other persons.

Aside from their research value these newspapers are fascinating reading—a wide open window to an earlier time. You'll be astonished by how much crime, hanky panky and political shenanigans took place in those days. There is enough reading material here to keep you entertained for years to come, and you will even find yourself wanting to go back to re-read them time and again, not just for the news, but also for the period advertisements.

Most of these newspapers are bound into one-month volumes, with a few being bound into 2- or 3-month volumes. The main exception is that the 1933 issues are bound into one-week volumes. During most of the 1917-1937 period the *Santa Fe New Mexican* published six issues a week, Monday through Saturday. In a very few cases a color comics section will be found after the Saturday edition. There was no Sunday edition.

The newspapers measure approximately 18 x 22 inches, and each daily issue contains anywhere from six to twelve pages.

The volume covers consist of heavy paper with a narrow strip of binding cloth along the spine. Some volumes have bindings that are glued only, others are both stapled and glued. A very few volumes are hard-bound, as noted in the inventory list below.

## **CONDITION: PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY**

These papers are old, dusty, and yellowed. Many of the covers are dirty and/or torn. But the newspapers themselves are mostly in decent shape. They are not particularly brittle, and only occasionally will a piece of a page be found to be torn or missing. Occasional stains will be found, primarily on the covers.

Some prior owner(s) did not properly store them, and many of the bindings will be found to have mouse chew. (Mice find the glue in bindings to be irresistible snacking material.) There are a very few volumes in which the mouse chew goes very slightly into the printed area.

These newspapers, therefore, are being sold as-is, priced as follows.

### **PRICING**

We are offering these as a single lot, all 100+ volumes for \$600, as-is, where-is. This is about *half* of our original acquisition cost. We cannot ship, but if you purchase **and pay for** these at least one week before the March 17, 2019 annual license plate meet in Albuquerque, we can deliver them to the meet. The total weight is probably in the vicinity of 200 lbs. Because of the number of volumes and their weight you will need a small SUV or something equivalent to transport them. It would be difficult to fit them into a passenger car.
